The Namibia Private Practitioners Forum (NPPF) invites you to a pivotal event on the **16th January 2025**, focused on a groundbreaking cost study and the development of an alternative to the outdated NAMAf Benchmark Tariff.

This initiative seeks to address systemic challenges in private healthcare funding and create a sustainable framework that prioritizes improving both healthcare practitioners' (HCPs) and patients' interests.


For over a decade, the private healthcare sector has struggled under the weight of an outdated NAMAf Benchmark Tariff. The tariff, rooted in an obsolete 2003 RSA BHF coding structure, has proven inadequate, unscientific, and unable to address the needs of modern healthcare. Recommendations from a 2014 cost study have been ignored, leaving the industry stagnant and many practitioners undercompensated for critical services.

Recognizing the urgency for change, the NPPF is spearheading an initiative to develop an independent costing model that prioritizes fairness, scientific integrity, and representation.
